Position Overview:

Eastside Student Center is seeking an enthusiastic, dedicated Program Lead to assist with and grow our youth-focused programs, including the Fowler Street Center, Line Street Center, and various after-school clubs and activities. The Program Lead will play a key role in supporting youth ages 10-18 by facilitating activities, building positive relationships with participants, and overseeing all aspects of program implementation. The ideal candidate will have experience working with youth, a passion for community care, and a commitment to creating safe, inclusive spaces for young people.

Key Responsibilities:

- **Programs & Activities:** In cooperation with the Program Managers/Director, you'll run program activities aligned with Eastside Student Center's mission, including games, workshops, art projects, and outdoor activities. You'll be vital in helping maintain program standards, and adapting activities to meet kids' needs.
- **Mentorship & Relationship Building:** Program leads will provide guidance and mentorship, to foster a safe and inclusive environment for all by modeling respectful, responsible, and kind behaviors and choices. You'll get to learn and practice in Eastside Student Center's program facilitator training, and apply methods with an iterative approach, and support from Program Manager/Program Director.
- **Youth Engagement:** Actively encourage youth involvement in games, programs & activities. Support youth leadership by empowering participants to take on community-oriented roles and following their lead in day-to-day activity choices.
- **Operational Support:** Work closely with the Eastside Student Center team to ensure that all operational needs, such as scheduling, supply procurement, and cleaning & facility upkeep, are met.
- **Outreach & Community Partnership:** Promote the center's programs and events to increase participation and engagement at various community events throughout the year.
- **Program Evaluation:** Track and document attendance via the Procare app. Regularly assess program effectiveness, providing recommendations for improvements, help collect feedback on programming from students and parents in collaboration with the Program Manager.



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Qualifications:

- Good interpersonal and communication skills: able to work as part of a team and relate to youth
- You like teens (13-18) and want to work with them
- Desire and willingness to learn and grow
- Ability to work flexible hours 2-5 days/week
- Comfortable with: playing active games, lifting up to 20lbs, walking one or more miles daily, standing for extended periods, cleaning up big messes, trying new things
- Child development knowledge preferred
- Comfortable playing PS5 games and first-person shooters specifically
- Bilingual preferred (Spanish)
